DLC Industry Advisory Committee Meeting Q3 2020

1. Agenda Review and Announcements

- Tina Halfpenny introduced Doug Paton, the DLC's new Technical Manager focusing on smart buildings, IoT, and controls interoperability
- GUV white paper for DLC members is being released in late October
- Manufacturer webinar, **More Precision on your DLC Submission**, will be held October 7, 2020 from 1p-2:30p ET.

2. NLC Savings Study Review

Bagwat Mohan highlighted a new joint NLC savings report with NEEA, titled "Energy Savings from Networked Lighting Control NLC Systems with and without LLLC." This study utilized the 2017 study's data and expanded the project's sample size. The full report is available on the DLC website and an overview webinar will be held on October 15.

3. NLC Industry Partner Interviews

Levin Nock discussed strategic planning to prioritize the best ways to support the installation and adoption of listed NLC systems. Levin asked the committee for recommendations on who the DLC should interview for insights.

4. Pathways to Zero NLC Study Review

Dorene presented the findings from the **Opportunity Areas for NLCs: Beyond Code/Net Zero Energy** study.

5. Hort Technical Requirements Changes and Release Schedule

Kasey Holland gave updates on the Hort V2.0 Technical Requirements, including alignment with ASABE S640, UL 8800 and TM33-18 reporting requirements, and two new optional reported metrics. The requirements also introduce new application types: family grouping and private label. Kasey reviewed the Hort V2 timeline:

- V2.0 Effective March 2021
- V2.1 effective July 2021

Kasey reviewed the Hort Webinar Wednesday success.

6. Member Program Updates

Lani Malapan gave updates on Member incentive program summaries. She shared results from a member survey on the impact of COVID-19 on utility and energy efficiency programs.

7. IAC Elections
