Bernadette is leading DOE's effort called DEIR in Lighting. The goal is to expand the pipeline of diverse candidates and help create a pathway into the lighting industry. A summary of this roundtable is currently on the DOE website.

Edward is currently working on the DEIR committee with IES. In addition, Edward launched LightJustice.org. LightJustice.org is resource and platform working to make lighting more equitable.

NLC Update

DLC6 will introduce NLC software characterization and revise the NLC Application and QPL data by removing some fields and lessening application burden. DLC6 will add some new fields about software.

The group discussed Control Persistence requirement for DLC qualifications.

CLTC REAL Project

The DLC's involvement in CLTC REAL Project, (Renewable Energy & Advanced Lighting Systems for Exterior Applications), a hybrid luminaire project (solar powered exterior luminaires) in underserved communities was reviewed.

LUNA/Outdoor Lighting Subcommittee Update

The DLC is building relationships with cities to help them understand the value of light and beneficial darkness.

The Outdoor Lighting Subcommittee has had five of the six meetings they committed to.

Hort 2023 Expansion

Kasey discussed the DLC Hort program from inception in 2017 to present day and the plans for the future expansion.

Hort Version 3.0 Goals include:

- Application information to allow user to select the correct product
- Adding more controls at the luminaire level and be dimmable
- Hort Surveillance testing program

2023 IAC Structure & Election

The current committee composition and empty seats currently available were discussed. It was noted that the charter needs to be updated to include a succession/replacement policy when companies merge. The timeline for nominations/elections was also reviewed.
